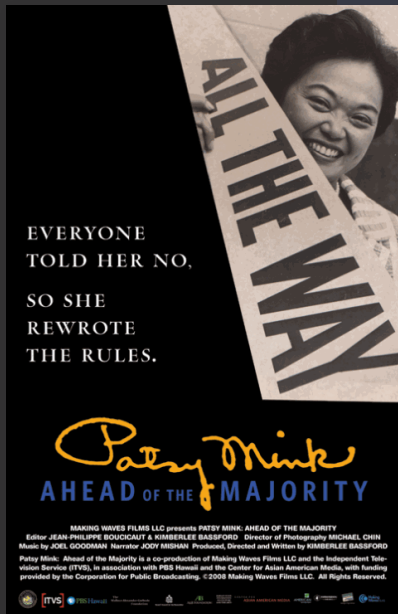

**U.S. Representative Patsy Takemoto Mink** was the first woman of color and the first Asian American woman elected to Congress, serving from 1965-1977 and again from 1990 until her death in 2002. In addition, she co-authored Title IX, the landmark legislation that mandated gender equity in education and athletics, which was later renamed the Patsy T. Mink Equal Opportunity in Education Act. *Patsy Mink: Ahead of the Majority* explores the remarkable political story of Mink as she redefined American politics in the face of racial and gender discrimination.
